Parents who suspect their child has a disability are advised to contact their local school district or the East Valley SELPA. Federal and state laws require public schools to provide free and appropriate education for children with special needs. Children/youth birth through 21 years of age may qualify for special education programs in public schools. Special education staff will help parents identify appropriate programs based upon assessment and eligibility for services.
